

2022 Wrath Pinot Noir, Lemoravo Vineyard Santa Lucia Highlands



Tasting Notes: Lemoravo Vineyard sits at 400 feet above the Salinas Valley floor, on the eastern slopes of the Santa Lucia Highlands. It is a small vineyard, only 28 acres, and is part of Kirk Williams' portfolio of properties. As a tribute to this land's history, the name is a three-word portmanteau as a tribute to its former crops: Lemons, Oranges and Avocados. This is Wrath's third bottling of Lemoravo Vineyard fruit. The wine begins with aromas of cherry and plum with a hint of herbs and opens to more red plum and cherry on the palate. The mouthfeel is juicy and bright with youthful acidity from its cold growing environment.
